The Bangladesh Rural Electrification Board has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Technical Assistance Project For Institutional Strengthening of Rural Electrification Program (TAPP) Project, BREB under Rural Electricity Transmission and Distribution (T&D) Project of IDA, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for procurement of Four Wheel Drive Patrol Operated cross country Utility Vehicle (Jeep) and Four Cylinder Gasoline Engine Micro Bus (04 Doors).

2. The Bangladesh Rural Electrification Board now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders. Bidders may bid, as further defined in the bidding document. Goods to be delivered in designated warehouse within Bangladesh as follows:

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

4. The Pre-Bid meeting shall be held at Office of the Project Director, Technical Assistance Project for Institutional Strengthening of Rural Electrification Program (TAPP) Project, Bangladesh Rural Electrification Board, Training Academy Building (1st Floor), Nikunja-2, Khilkhet, City: Dhaka-1229, Bangladesh on **07.06.2018** at **11.00 AM** hours local time (GMT+6 hours).

6. Eligibility and Qualifications requirements: Manufacturer or supplier having the following qualifications:

(i) The Bidder (in case of JV, each partner) should have **at least five (5) years** of general experience in supplying goods and related services. The manufacturer should have **at least five (5) years** of relevant manufacturing experience.

(ii) The Bidder shall at-least have experience of supplying similar goods (i.e. Four Wheel Drive Utility Vehicle (Jeep) and Four Cylinder Gasoline Engine Micro Bus (04 Doors)) having value mentioned below in not more than two contracts, within the last five (5) years:

At least US\$ 35,000 or equivalent;

(iii) Bidder shall have at least the Average Annual Turnover mentioned below over a period of best three years within last five years.

At least US\$ 44,000 or equivalent;

(iv) The Bidder at the time of bid submission should have at least the amount of liquid asset or working capital or credit facility or their combination mentioned below:

At least US\$ 40,000 or equivalent;

Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.

A margin of preference for certain goods manufactured domestically "shall" be applied.

7. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of equivalent US\$ 50. The method of payment will be Bank Draft or Pay Order in favor of Bangladesh Rural Electrification Board, Dhaka. Late bids will be rejected.
